New Client On-Boarding

Once a client decides that he/she would like to retain our services we send a link for on-boarding. Clients pay the quoted retainer, sign our contract, and complete intake forms and releases.

Filing of Pleadings & Initial Disclosures

Once on-boarding is completed, client files are sent to our attorneys to file proper pleadings with the court. Petitions are generally filed 24 -72 hours after on-boarding is completed. Client are then asked to begin gathering documents for initial disclosures.

Case Strategy Meeting

Once all pleadings have been filed, clients are scheduled for a meeting with their attorney to discuss next steps. We will discuss all issues regarding your case in detail.
